# CAMP DIRECTOR

## AMY MORRIS

Amy is in her first year with the Binghamton University volleyball program. Before arriving at Binghamton the program had advanced to four consecutive America East berths, including two 2<sup>nd</sup> place finishes. The 2005 squad took home the championship trophy and advanced to the NCAA Tournament for the first time in Division I school history.



As a University of Tennessee graduate, and former player, Morris played outside hitter and libero. In her junior year as an outside hitter she was named SEC Defensive Player of the Year, first team all-region, and AVCA All-American. Her team finished as the SEC champions and was ranked 9th in the country. In her senior season as the team's libero she proceeded to break three digging records and led her team to the Final Four in San Antonio. Morris has also competed professionally in Puerto Rico and Indonesia, as well as being an active competitor in beach volleyball.
