Bearcats sixth out of 19 at Dartmouth Invitational

Binghamton placed sixth at the 36-hole Dartmouth Invitational, shooting 306-298=604 at the par-71 Hanover Country Club. Yale won the event going away with a two-day total of 585. Army and Hartford tied for second (596), followed by Boston College (598) and Dartmouth (603). The Bearcats did finish ahead of region rival Central Connecticut State (7th at 606).

Hendrickson shares medalist honors

Senior **Keith Hendrickson (Syosset, N.Y.)** fired rounds of 71-72=143 to share medalist honors with a player from Yale. Among a field of 114, Hendrickson played the course in 1-over par, earning his first individual collegiate title. He collected a tournament-best eight birdies over the 36 holes, and played the par fives in a collective 2-under. Hendrickson has an outstanding scoring average of 73.0 thus far this fall.

Mattingly earns trip to Dartmouth

Sophomore **Matt Mattingly (Manlius, N.Y./Centennial)** won an intersquad playoff to earn a trip to the Dartmouth Invitational, where he played as an individual. In his first competition of the fall, he shot 79-73=152 to tie for 33rd place. Mattingly's 2-over 73 on Sunday featured an eagle.

Lasky juggling lineup in search of best results

Because of the parity in the middle of the lineup this fall, first-year head coach Nick Lasky has selected three different starting units in the first three tournaments. Senior captain **Eric Vinal (Syracuse, N.Y./Nottingham)** sat out the Dartmouth event, and senior **Joe Kunz (Webster, N.Y.)** and sophomore **Kevin Crawford (Lockport, N.Y.)** — both starters from BU's 2003 NCAA team — have each been bumped from the lineup once. Lasky is looking to bridge the scoring gap between his top-three players and the remainder of the team.

Up Next: Cornell Invitational

Binghamton will return to familiar Central New York territory this weekend at the Cornell Invitational. The Bearcats own a 74-11 overall record at the Robert Trent Jones Cornell GC, having won tournaments the last two times entered (1991 and 1992). Binghamton also enjoyed great success in the combined Cornell-Colgate Invitational, which ran from 1993 to 2001. The team won the 2000 and 2001 events.
