Binghamton: Kevin Broadus (Bowie State '90), second season
Vermont: Mike Lonergan (Catholic '88), fourth season

The Matchup: Binghamton will look to move to 3-0 in the conference when they take on Vermont on Thursday night in the Events Center.

Media: Game will be televised regionally on Time Warner Sports with Roger Neel on the play-by-play and John Caveny on color. Robert Ford will be heard on commercial radio WNBC 1290 AM in the Binghamton area.

The Game

In a televised game on Time Warner Cable Sports, Binghamton faces its toughest America East opponent, historically, in the Vermont Catamounts tonight. Vermont owns a commanding 14-3 lead in the all-time series and has won six straight over the Bearcats. The last BU home win in the series was a wild 61-60 double overtime victory three years ago in the Events Center.

Scouting Binghamton

Binghamton (9-4, 2-0 AE) is on a roll, having won five in a row and eight of its last 10 games. On Monday, BU held off Stony Brook 67-60 to remain unbeaten in conference play. Senior guard **Dwayne Jackson** scored five points in the final 1:50 and sparked a late defensive stand. With BU clinging to a 56-55 lead inside two minutes remaining, Jackson grabbed a key offensive rebound and converted a difficult layup in traffic with 1:50 left for a 58-55 margin. On Stony Brook's next possession, Jackson knocked the ball away from a Seawolves player and the Bearcats turned that steal into a fastbreak layup by sophomore guard **Chretien Lukusa**, which pushed the lead to 60-55. Binghamton then recorded three blocks and another steal in a 49-second span to thwart any Stony Brook comeback. Jackson converted 3-of-4 free throws in the final 35 seconds and Lukusa sank 2-of-2 to wrap up BU's fifth win in six home games this season. Five BU players reached double figures, led by junior guard **D.J. Rivera**, who scored a game-high 16 points. Rivera, who ranks 18th in the nation in scoring (21.0 ppg.), collected 12 of his points in the pivotal second half. Jackson, Lukusa and junior guard **Emanuel Mayben** had 11 points apiece and senior forward **Reggie Fuller** added 10 points and a pair of blocks.

Scouting Vermont

The Catamounts (9-4, 0-0 AE) have won six of their last eight heading into their America East opener. Picked to finish second in the Coaches Preseason Poll, Vermont boasts defending conference Player of the Year and AP All-American **Marqus Blakely** as well as three-time all-conference point guard **Mike Trimboli**. The high-powered offense is averaging nearly 78 points per game, thanks to 48% shooting. In its last outing, UVM beat NJIT 73-47 on Saturday. The team owns wins over Colorado (84-59), George Washington (83-72), UNC Wilmington (89-68) and its four losses were all to top-tier opponents (Pitt, Maryland, Colorado State, George Mason). Trimboli is hitting 51% of his three-point attempts and as a team, Vermont converts 72% at the free throw line, making them difficult to beat from behind. Blakely has been playing in front of NBA scouts and he produced 19 points and 14 rebounds against No. 3 Pitt.

Up Next: Flight to Utah, road test at Albany

The Bearcats bus to New York City immediately after the game and depart tomorrow morning for Orem, Utah and a Saturday night game against Utah Valley. It will be the team's final non-conference game of the season. Then the Bearcats will play at Albany next Wednesday.

BEARCAT NOTES

Win over Stony Brook makes it five straight wins for BU

The Bearcats notched their fifth straight win when they defeated Stony Brook on Jan. 5. The win streak is good for the second-best at the Division I level. The 2004-05 and the 2007-08 squads each won five in a row. The school record for consecutive wins is six, which was set by the 2005-06 team, all against America East opponents.

Jackson displays senior poise in final minutes of recent wins

Senior wing and sixth-man **Dwayne Jackson** showed a knack for heady play in the final minutes of BU's wins over Tulane on Dec. 27 and Stony Brook on Jan. 5. With less than three minutes to go at Tulane, Jackson knocked down a three-pointer and then later followed a missed bucket with a tip-in to help secure a one-point win over the Green Wave. A little over a week later, Jackson scored five points in the final 1:50 and made a key steal to help Binghamton hold off Stony Brook for another hard-fought victory.

Mayben finds three-point shooting touch against Stony Brook

Junior guard **Emanuel Mayben** shot 3-of-4 from three pointers in Binghamton's win over Stony Brook on Jan. 5. The point guard shot 4-of-6 from the floor for the second straight game after doing it on Jan. 3 against Maine and his three three-pointers made is his new career high. Prior to the game against Stony Brook, Mayben was only 2-of-17 (12%) on three-point field goals. Mayben finished his night against Stony Brook with 11 points, marking the fourth straight game he has scored in double figures.

Rivera leading the conference in scoring

Junior guard **D.J. Rivera** is currently leading the America East conference in scoring with a 21.0 point per game average. A Bearcat has never finished the season atop the scoring chart. Former Bearcat Andre Heard had the best showing of any player donning the green and white, ranking third in the AE in scoring (17.1 per game) at the end of the 2005-06 season. Rivera is also currently ranked 18th in the nation in scoring.

Fuller among best in AE in field goal percentage

Senior forward and captain **Reggie Fuller** is currently ranked third in the America East with a .547 (58-106) field goal percentage. Last season, Fuller ranked first in the AE in conference games in field goal percentage with a .627 clip and although Fuller fell just under the minimum of 3.0 field goals made per game to be eligible for the overall rankings, his .609 percentage would ranked him second in the AE.

Scoring 20+ points is no problem at all for D.J. Rivera

Junior guard D.J. Rivera has scored over 20 points in 10 of his first 13 games in a Bearcat uniform, including in a school-record seven straight games Dec. 6 to Jan. 3. If Rivera continues his high-scoring ways, he will no doubt approach Andre Heard's DI school record of scoring over 20 points in 16 games during his career. Anthony Green ranks a close second to Heard, as he scored over 20 points in 15 games during his career.

Mayben and Alvin team up to create high-producing point guard tandem

Junior guards **Emanuel Mayben** and **Malik Alvin** are each averaging over four assists per game this season for the Bearcats. Mayben is ranked third in the AE with 4.5 assists per game and Alvin ranks fourth in the conference with 4.4 assists per contest. Mayben and Alvin, who both share duties each game setting up the offense, are also tied for third in the conference in assists-to-turnover ratio (1.4 each).

Bearcats looking to become fastest BU team in Division I history to win 10 games

With a win over Vermont tonight, Binghamton would move to 10-4 on the season, earning 10 wins in the first 14 games of the season. That feat would shatter the previous record that the 2002-03 team set, when they tallied 10 wins in their first 17 games of the season. Last season, it took Binghamton 20 games to pick up their tenth win.

Binghamton off to its best record in 15 years

With an 9-4 mark after 13 games, Binghamton is off to its best record in 15 years, since the 1993-94 season, and the best ever start as a Division I team. The 1993-94 squad won 12 of their first 13 games.

Rivera launches himself into BU record book with 20+ point scoring streak

Junior guard **D.J. Rivera** crushed a Division I Bearcat record by scoring 20+ points in seven consecutive games. Rivera accomplished the feat against Rutgers (23), Bucknell (21), Manhattan (23), Rider (22), Tulane (24), Marist (22) and Maine (24). The previous record of scoring over 20 points in consecutive games was shared by Nick Billings and Andre Heard, who each did it in three straight games. Billings was the first to do it in the 2003-04 season and Andre Heard put together two strings of three-straight 20-point games in the 2005-06 season.

Dwayne Jackson makes his mark on BU career scoring, three-pointers lists

Senior wing **Dwayne Jackson** is currently ranked 11th on Binghamton's DI career scoring chart with 506 points. Jackson is 11 points away from passing Brandon Carter (2002-04) and moving into the school's top ten list. Jackson also recently cracked the school's top five three-point field goals made list when he moved ahead of Richard Forbes (2006-08). The Akron, Ohio native now has 76 career treys.

Bearcats pick up 100th Division I victory

With their 70-62 win at Maine on Jan. 3, the Bearcats won their 100th game at the Division I level. Binghamton joined the Division I ranks in the 2001-02 season and this is the school's eight season competing as a Division I school.

D.J. Rivera named AE Player of the Week for second time

Junior guard **D.J. Rivera** received his second America East player of the week award on Dec. 29 after averaging 23 points and nine rebounds in Binghamton's previous two wins over Rider and Tulane. Rivera recorded his third double-double of the season against Rider (22 pts, 10 rebs) and at that point had scored over 20 points in five straight games, a school record. Rivera ranks first in the conference in scoring. Rivera, who also received player of the week honors on Dec. 8th, is only the second Bearcat to receive multiple AE player of the week honors and the first since 2002-03 when Anthony Green did it three times.

Bearcats pass Conference USA test in Tulane

On December 27, Binghamton defeated Tulane 74-73 in New Orleans. The game marked the first time that the Bearcats had played a Conference USA team and can now claim a 1-0 record against the conference. Junior guard **D.J. Rivera** scored 24 points, 22 of which came in the second half, to vault the Bearcats to victory. The win, accompanied with BU's win at Rutgers earlier this season, is helping to form an impressive resume for the Bearcats under second-year head coach Kevin Broadus.

Jackson provides scoring threat off the bench

Senior wing **Dwayne Jackson** is currently ranked second on the team in scoring (11.6 ppg) this year while only starting one game. Jackson has embraced his role as a spark off the bench and leads the team in three pointers made. Coming off the bench is nothing new for Jackson, who has been a key contributor to the team throughout his career while only making seven career starts. Jackson has scored in double-figures 25 times in his career and has scored 500 career points.

Fuller's steady play carries over from 2007-08 campaign

Senior forward **Reggie Fuller** has been a model of consistency for the Bearcats since he arrived on campus prior to the 2007-08 season. Last season as a junior, Fuller averaged a shade under seven points and six rebounds per contest while starting 26 games. Fuller racked up three double-doubles last season and shot an outstanding .627 percent from the floor in conference games. This season the forward is averaging 10.2 points and 7.0 rebounds per game. Fuller notched a 12-point, 10-rebound performance against CCSU on Nov. 25 and a 16-point, 15-rebound night against Marist on Dec. 30.

Camara makes presence felt in return to lineup

Sophomore wing **Moussa Camara** played a key role in Binghamton's 69-58 win over Rider on Tuesday. After missing most of the season due to a preseason nose injury, Camara netted 13 crucial first-half points against Rider in only his second game of the season. Camara made his return to the team on Dec. 20 against Manhattan and was rewarded by earning a start against the Jaspers. The sharpshooter averaged 10.0 points in his first two games back.

Bearcats bench received a much needed boost

After using no more than eight players during a four game stretch (against Utah Valley, Quinnipiac, Rutgers and Bucknell), the Bearcats just got a much-needed boost on their bench against Manhattan on December 20. Sophomore guards **Moussa Camara** and **Chretien Lukusa** returned from injury and sophomore center **Theo Davis** made his Bearcat debut after fulfilling his transfer requirements. The new-look Bearcats used 11 players against Manhattan and were able to equal their highest scoring output of the season (80).

Bearcats get their big time win over Big East's Rutgers

December 6, 2008 will go down in Binghamton history as the day the Bearcats got their first win over a Big East school. Heading into the matchup at Rutgers, Binghamton was a dismal 0-6 against Big East member schools, having lost four previous games to Syracuse and one each to Villanova and Providence. Binghamton proved ready to notch their first win against Rutgers, and left the RAC with a ten-point 66-56 victory. Junior guard **D.J. Rivera** scored a game-high 23 points and junior guard **Malik Alvin** netted 17 points to go along with six assists and three steals.

Rivera named America East Player of the Week

Junior guard **D.J. Rivera** was named America East Player of the Week for the week ending Dec. 7. Rivera, the leading scorer in the America East, led the Bearcats to a pair of road wins, including an upset of Big East member Rutgers. Against the Scarlet Knights, Rivera scored 16 of his game-high 23 points in the pivotal second half. For the game, he hit 8-of-12 from the floor and sank six free throws in the final 1:41 to seal the win. Rivera is the first Bearcat to earn a weekly award this year. Last year the Bearcats racked up two player of the week awards (Mike Gordon and Lazar Trifunovic).

Broadus announce three NLI signings for 2009-10 season

Second-year coach Kevin Broadus announced the signing of three players for the 2009-10 season. **Taylor Johnston** (Whiby, Ontario/West Hill Collegiate Institute) and **Dylan Talley** (Burlington, N.J./Life Center Academy) will join the team as freshmen and junior college transfer **Greer Wright** (Lake Worth, Fla./City College of San Francisco) will join the team with two remaining years of eligibility. Johnston, a 6-foot-7, 200-pound guard, chose Binghamton over Ivy League member Cornell among others. He averaged 17.0 points, 7.1 rebounds and 4.0 assists as a junior at West Hill Collegiate. Johnston played summer ball with current Bearcats sophomore **Chretien Lukusa**, whose high school also battled Johnston's West Hill for Ontario bragging rights. Talley is a 6-foot-5, 215-pound guard who averaged 16.6 points and 4.6 rebounds for Life Center Academy in Burlington, N.J. The muscular wing shot 45% from the floor and received offers from Drexel, La Salle and Siena. Greer is a 6-foot-8, 200-pound forward from Florida who is playing his sophomore season at CCSF. As a freshman at Palm Beach CC in 2006-07, Greer averaged 6.4 points and 3.0 rebounds. He averaged 19.5 points and 8.0 rebounds as a senior at American Heritage High, earning all-area honors. He also played at Grandview Prep

Malik Alvin becomes immediate contributor

Junior guard **Malik Alvin** has been an important factor to the Bearcats' success in his first two games of the season. In his debut against Utah Valley, Alvin scored 14 points, including a key three-pointer and free throws late in the game. In his next game against Quinnipiac, Alvin scored 11 points while dishing out four assists. Alvin's best game yet may have been his 40-minute, 17-point, six-assist effort in BU's win over Rutgers. BU was 3-0 in Alvin's first three games.

Bearcats showing improvement in play away from the Events Center this season

Binghamton has already won four road games this season, earning victories at Quinnipiac, Rutgers, Tulane and Maine. In 2007-08, Binghamton did not win its first away game until January 12 with a conference win over Albany 71-57. Binghamton is currently 4-3 on the road this season after starting the year 0-8 away from home last year.

Rivera storms out of gate with pair of double-doubles

Junior guard **D.J. Rivera** seems to be comfortable with his new surroundings. The St. Joseph's transfer has amassed a double-double in each of his first team games in a Bearcat jersey. In his career debut against Mansfield, Rivera poured in 28 points to go along with 10 rebounds and then followed that performance with a 20 point, 10 rebound effort against George Washington.

Rivera sets BU debut record against Mansfield

Junior guard **D.J. Rivera** dropped in 28 points in his first ever game as a Bearcat against Mansfield on Nov. 17 in the teams opener. Rivera's scoring barrage marked the highest total ever scored in a Bearcat debut. The 28 points was also the most ever by a Bearcat in the Events Center. Rivera shot 11-of-20 from the floor, including four jams.

BU to celebrate fifth-year anniversary of Events Center opening

On January 31, 2009 at 2 p.m. the Bearcats will host Maine in what will be the five-year anniversary of the opening of the Events Center. Binghamton played its first game in the new facility on January 31, 2004 and defeated Hartford 75-68 in front of 4,660 fans. Since then, Binghamton has hosted four America East tournaments (three men's and one woman's) while the men's team has led the conference in attendance five consecutive years.

PRESEASON NOTES

- Two starters and seven letterwinners return from a 14-16 team that tied for fourth (out of nine) in the America East and was eliminated in the conference tournament quarterfinals.
- Under Coach Kevin Broadus, Binghamton made a three-game improvement in the America East standings (9-7) and equaled the program's second-highest win percentage in seven years of Division I league play (56.3%).
- Since joining the America East in 2001, Binghamton has the third-best win percentage in league play (52%), behind only Vermont and Boston University.
- With its state-of-the-art 5,142-seat Events Center, Binghamton has led the America East in attendance for five consecutive years. The Bearcats drew an average crowd of 3,645 in 2007-08, an increase of more than 400 fans per game from 2006-07.
- Binghamton lost three starters who accounted for nearly 38 points per game in 2007-08 (Lazar Trifunovic, Mike Gordon and Richard Forbes).
- BU will have to replace graduated all-star point-guard Mike Gordon, who started 102 consecutive games to end his brilliant collegiate career
- The Bearcats will also have to replace leading scorer and rebounder Lazar Trifunovic (14.0 ppg., 7.1 rpg.).
- The two returning starters are junior forward Reggie Fuller (6.6 ppg., 5.7 rpg.) and sophomore guard Chretien Lukusa (4.3 ppg.).
- Broadus' recruiting efforts have landed eight newcomers on the 2008-09 roster

KEVIN BROADUS, BINGHAMTON UNIVERSITY'S MEN'S BASKETBALL COACH



After orchestrating a three-game improvement in the America East and a resurgence in local support, Kevin Broadus begins his second season as the head coach of the Binghamton basketball program in 2008-09.

The former Georgetown assistant and recruiting whiz quickly put his stamp on the Bearcats' program in 2007-08. The team matched Broadus' intensity and focus, and jumped up two spots in the conference standings while drawing record attendance numbers at the Events Center.

Now with a fresh crop of talented recruits, Broadus is poised to continue the program's ascent to the top of the America East.

At Georgetown, Broadus worked alongside head coach John Thompson III, and the Hoyas' recent national resurgence is a direct result of his recruiting success in the D.C. metro area. Last year's squad went 30-7 and won both the regular season and postseason Big East titles before advancing through the first four rounds of the NCAA tournament to the Final Four. The 2005-06 team went 23-10 and reached the NCAA "Sweet 16" and the 2004-05 team went 19-13 and advanced to the NIT quarterfinals.

Broadus was introduced as Binghamton's new head coach on March 26, 2007, just days before coaching Georgetown in the Final Four. Also, in the same month he was ranked No. 6 by online publication hoopscooponline.com on its list of the Top 100 Assistant Coaches in the College Game Today.

Prior to Georgetown, Broadus was an assistant coach at George Washington for three years. In 2003-04, his Colonials team won 18 games and was selected to the NIT. From 1998 to 2001, he was on the staff at American University and also had coaching stints at University of the District of Columbia (1994-97) and Bowie State University (Md.) (1990-93).

Broadus is known as an excellent recruiter and four of his former recruits are playing in the NBA. Three of his players from his time at George Washington were on NBA rosters in the 2006-07 season. Mike Hall played for the Washington Wizards, Pops Mensah-Bonsu played for the Dallas Mavericks and Danilo 'JR' Pinnock was with the Los Angeles Lakers.

Broadus' most-accomplished recruit is former Georgetown forward Jeff Green. He coached Green over a three-year span in which Green won Big East Co-Rookie of the Year honors, Big East second-team all-conference honors and the Big East Player of the Year award. Green and Broadus' Hoyas had a 30-7 record in 2006-07 and made it to the NCAA Final Four. Green was drafted fifth overall in the 2007 NBA draft by the Boston Celtics and was involved in a draft day trade, shipping him to Seattle.

Broadus earned his bachelor's degree in business administration from Bowie State in 1990 and went on to receive his master's degree in counseling from UDC in 1995.

He was a three-year letterwinner at Bowie State, earning conference all-rookie honors in 1984 and leading the team in scoring as team captain in his senior season. He played his first collegiate season at Grambling University in Louisiana. Broadus attended Dunbar High School in Washington, D.C., and Montgomery Blair High School in Silver Spring, Md.

In addition to his college coaching résumé, Broadus has worked as a summer camp coach and counselor for both the Philadelphia 76ers and the New York Knicks. He also served four years as a research assistant at the National Institute of Health in Bethesda.

Broadus and his wife, Belinda, have four children: Nicol (24), Milan (15), Paris (14) and Kevin Jr. (12).
