- 2006 America East Conference Regular Season Champions
- Four consecutive appearances in the America East Conference championship game (2003-06), a feat achieved by only one other program
- Two NCAA Division I Tournament appearances (2003 and 2006)
- Advanced to the second round of the 2003 NCAA Division I Tournament
- Nationally-ranked during the 2004 and 2005 seasons in both the adidas/NSCAA and *College Soccer News* weekly polls
- Graham Munro named a 2005 Third-Team All-American by *College Soccer News*
- Graham Munro named the America East Conference Defender of the Year three consecutive years (2003-05)
- Charles Darkwah named the America East Conference Striker of the Year in 2004
- 21 America East All-Conference selections since 2002
- Seven NSCAA Division I Regional All-America selections since 2003
- Charles Darkwah named an COSIDA Academic All-American in 2004
- Six NSCAA All-America Scholars since 2004
