Binghamton to play two key conference road matches this weekend

The fourth-place Binghamton volleyball team will have two critical matches this weekend with third-place Stony Brook and second-place UMBC on the road. Binghamton will look for a season sweep of Stony Brook on Friday night before heading to UMBC in hopes of a season split with the Retrievers on Saturday. The Bearcats currently have a one-game lead over fifth-place New Hampshire. The top four teams make the America East Postseason Tournament. Binghamton has made the tournament five straight times (2004-08).

This weekend's opponents

Stony Brook is 12-11, 4-3 AE and is coming off a 3-1 win over Hartford. UMBC enters the weekend at 13-9, 5-2 AE. Two weekends ago, Stony Brook and UMBC split a weekend series, with each time winning at home. Both teams will also play first-place and undefeated Albany this weekend.

Last time out

In their last game this past Sunday, Binghamton dropped a three-setter at home to New Hampshire. **Michelle McDonough** and **Dawn Lammert** each had nine kills in defeat for BU.

Chasing 1,000

Hitter **Michelle McDonough** is looking to become just the second junior to amass 1,000 career kills at the Division I level at Binghamton. McDonough enters the weekend with 992 career kills, 333 of which have come this season.

Lammert earns academic honor

Binghamton volleyball co-captain **Dawn Lammert** was named to the District I Volleyball All-Academic First Team as presented by ESPN The Magazine and selected by College Sports Information Directors of America (CoSIDA) on Thursday. Lammert was one of seven members selected to the first team and is now eligible for the Academic All-America Team to be named later this year. The graduate biology student is the only member of the America East to be named to an Academic All-District team. Last year, Lammert was chosen to the America East All-Academic team and had the highest GPA of all the honorees. Her current cumulative GPA is a 3.94. She graduated with a bachelor's of biology in just three years and currently has senior year athletic eligibility.

Up Next: Two home matches to wrap up regular season

Next week Binghamton will host Syracuse in a non-conference match on Tuesday before hosting their regular season finale against Hartford on Friday night.
