### Scouting Binghamton

Binghamton (6-13, 5-5 AE) is on a two-game losing streak, having lost 63-53 at first-place Maine on Saturday. Junior forward **Rachel Laws (Wyncote, N.Y.)** and freshman center Laine Kurpniece (Riga, Latvia) each had a team-high 11 points. Junior forward Jen Haubrich (Bow, N.H.) added 10 points.

Laws, who has reached double figures in scoring the past six games, continues to lead the team with 15.1 points and 7.1 rebounds per game. She ranks fourth in the America East Conference in scoring and is seventh in rebounding. Freshman guard **Laura Sario (Espoo, Finland)** is second on the team with 9.3 points per game. Haubrich is third with 8.2 points per game.

### Scouting Albany

Albany (10-9, 5-5 AE) had its three-game unbeaten streak snapped at home on Saturday, losing 71-61 to New Hampshire. Junior guard Jen Schumacher paced the Great Danes with a team-high 14 points.

Senior center Danielle Hutcheson is ranked eighth in the conference with 14.1 points per game and is first with 9.1 rebounds and 1.47 blocks per game. Senior guard Alicia Learn leads the conference with 2.05 steals per game.

### The series against Albany

Binghamton leads the all-time series 17-16. The Bearcats won the first meeting this year, 57-47, on Jan. 12 at the RAC Center. Junior forward **Jen Haubrich (Bow, N.H.)** had a game-high and career-high 18 points as the Bearcats snapped a nine-game losing streak.

Binghamton has won six consecutive home games against Albany, dating back to Nov. 23, 1992. A win over the Great Danes would give the Bearcats their first season sweep in the series since the 2001-02 campaign.

# **BEARCATS BY THE NUMBERS**

Against Marshall on Nov. 27, Binghamton set the school record for the highest three-point field goal percentage in a game. The Bearcats went 7-for-9 for a .778 percentage.

Binghamton shot a team-best 80 percent from the free throw line against Maine on Saturday, connecting on 12-of-15 attempts.

## MOST RECENT MEETING

### Binghamton 57, Albany 47 • Jan. 12, 2005

ALBANY, N.Y.— Junior forward [Jen Haubrich](#) netted a career-high and game-high 18 points, leading Binghamton (2-10, 1-2 AE) to a 57-47 win over Albany (6-6, 1-2 AE) in an America East Conference women's basketball game at the RAC Center. The victory snapped the Bearcats' nine-game losing streak.

Haubrich's 18 points eclipsed her previous career-high of 13 points against Brown on Nov. 28. Her seven field goals were also a career high. She scored 10 of her points in the second half.

Also reaching double figures for Binghamton were freshman guard [Laura Sario](#) with 12 points, junior guard [Jen Blues](#) with 11 points and a career-high three blocks, and junior forward [Rachel Laws](#), who posted her third double-double of the season with 16 points and 11 rebounds.

Binghamton came out smoking in the first half, jumping out to a 32-18 lead at the break. Blues and Sario each connected on three three-point shots and the Bearcats were 11-for-24 from the field. Their largest lead was 31-12 with 5:47 left to go in the half.

Albany wouldn't go quietly and kept chipping away at the lead in the second half. The Great Danes cut the deficit as low as 50-44 on a three pointer by Maree Jones with 1:41 remaining.

Laws, however, saved the day for the Bearcats when she converted a three-point play with 1:06 to go. Blues and Laws then combined to go 4-of-4 from the free throw line in the final minute of the game.
