Scouting Binghamton

Binghamton (6-12, 5-4 AE) had its two-game winning streak snapped at Hartford, 51-56, on Wednesday. Junior forward **Rachel Laws (Wyncote, N.Y.)** paced Binghamton with 15 points and also added five rebounds and two steals. Freshman guard **Laura Sario (Espoo, Finland)** also reached double figures in scoring with 11 points. She also had a team-high eight rebounds and three assists.

Laws, who is the current America East Conference Co-Player of the Week, continues to lead the team with 15.3 points and 7.2 rebounds per game. She ranks third in the America East Conference in scoring and is sixth in rebounding. Sario, the current America East Conference Co-Rookie of the Week, ranks second on the team with 9.3 points per game.

Scouting Maine

Maine (11-8, 7-2 AE) has won four consecutive games and is tied for first place in the America East Conference. Most recently, the Black Bears went into Boston on Wednesday and came away with a 73-55 win over the Terriers. Senior guard Kim Corbitt led the way with 21 points while senior guard Missy Traversi, who leads the team with 13.1 points per game, added 17 points.

The series against Maine

The Blacks led the all-time series 6-1, having won the previous five meetings. Earlier this season, Maine won 73-56 at the Events Center on Jan. 5. Ashley Underwood had a game-high 17 points while freshman center Laine Kurpniece (Riga, Latvia) had a team-high 12 points and nine rebounds for the Bearcats.

Binghamton's three losses at Alfond Arena have come by a total of eight points, including last season's 58-55 decision on Jan. 7, 2004.

The lone Binghamton win over Maine was a 85-71 home triumph on Jan. 19, 2002.

PAST GAME SUMMARIES

Maine 73, Binghamton 56 • Jan. 5, 2005

VESTAL, N.Y.— Visiting Maine shot a sizzling 61% in the second to pull away from Binghamton. The defending conference champion Black Bears put five players in double figures and stretched a 10-point halftime cushion. The loss was Binghamton's seventh straight.

Maine was led by its inside tandem of 6-foot senior forward Monica Peterson and 6-foot-3 junior center Abby Schrader. The pair was on the receiving end of countless passes over the top of BU's defense, and combined for 29 points and 16 rebounds, with Peterson reaching a double-double with 13 points and 13 rebounds. Sophomore guard Ashley Underwood scored a game-high 17 points on 6-for-8 shooting.

For Binghamton, freshman center **Laine Kurpniece** had a strong game, contributing team-highs of 12 points and nine rebounds. Junior forward **Jen Haubrich** chipped in 10 points.

Maine 64, Binghamton 43 • Feb. 7, 2004

VESTAL, N.Y.—Visiting Maine put four players in double figures and won its 26th straight regular season game against America East competition, defeating Binghamton. The game was the first women's basketball game at Binghamton's \$33.1 million Events Center.

Sophomore guard **Rachel Laws** allied game-highs of 15 points and eight rebounds, and senior forward **Leala Wegwerth** chipped in 11 points.

Maine 58, Binghamton 55 • Jan. 7, 2004

ORONO, Maine - Maine built a double-digit lead and then withstood a late rally to hold off visiting Binghamton 58-55. It marked the third time in as many seasons that the Bearcats have lost at Maine in the final seconds.

During the early stages of the game, it appeared as if Binghamton would end its frustration at Alford Arena as it opened up a 15-8 lead midway through the first half. The Black Bears, however, turned on the defensive pressure and by halftime, they had taken a 29-27 advantage.

In the second half, Maine tried to deliver the knockout, as it took a commanding 56-42 lead with 6:33 left in the game. The Bearcats, however, refused to go quietly, as they ripped off a 13-0 run to cut the lead to one, 56-55, with 2.3 seconds left.

Even after Maine sank two free throws with 1.3 seconds to go, the game was in doubt until senior guard **Kate Townley** fired a desperation three-point shot at the buzzer that went off the backboard.

Junior center **Kristin Hibler** tied her career-high with 16 points, senior forward **Leala Wegwerth** added 15 points and nine rebounds, and sophomore forward **Rachel Laws** chipped in 14 points and seven rebounds.
